Few of the many activities one could choose can match the exhilaration, challenges, and rewards of flying. One of the first steps in learning to fly is taking "ground"

school"— your preparation for the world of flight!

Sugar Valley Airport offers ground school *free of*charge as a service to the aviation community.

This course is **unique** in that participants get to ask questions *real time* and learn from others in the enthusiastic aviation community. The course is taught by a commercially certificated pilot with an advanced ground instructor rating who is a member of the FAA Safety Team, the Society of Aviation and Flight Educators (SAFE), The Ninety-Nines and Civil Air Patrol. The suggested textbook is *Rod Machado's Private-Commercial Pilot Handbook*,



supplemented by Gleim's *Private Pilot FAA Knowledge Test* book, the FAA's *Pilot's Handbook of Aeronautical Knowledge, Airplane Flying Handbook,* and *Aviation Weather Handbook.* In this 12-week online course with two-hour classes, students will learn about the following topics, shown in the proposed schedule below:
